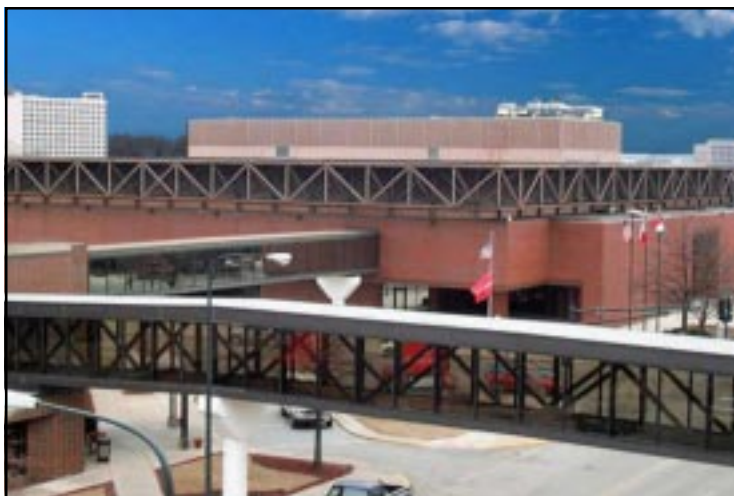
Greetings From Iowa

Rev. Dr. Stuart Briscoe

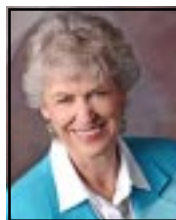
Morning Bible Hour on Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday
