





New churches tend to break new ground. They bring new life, new methods of doing ministry, new neighborhoods and cities to the Church, and new people who have never been involved in any church.

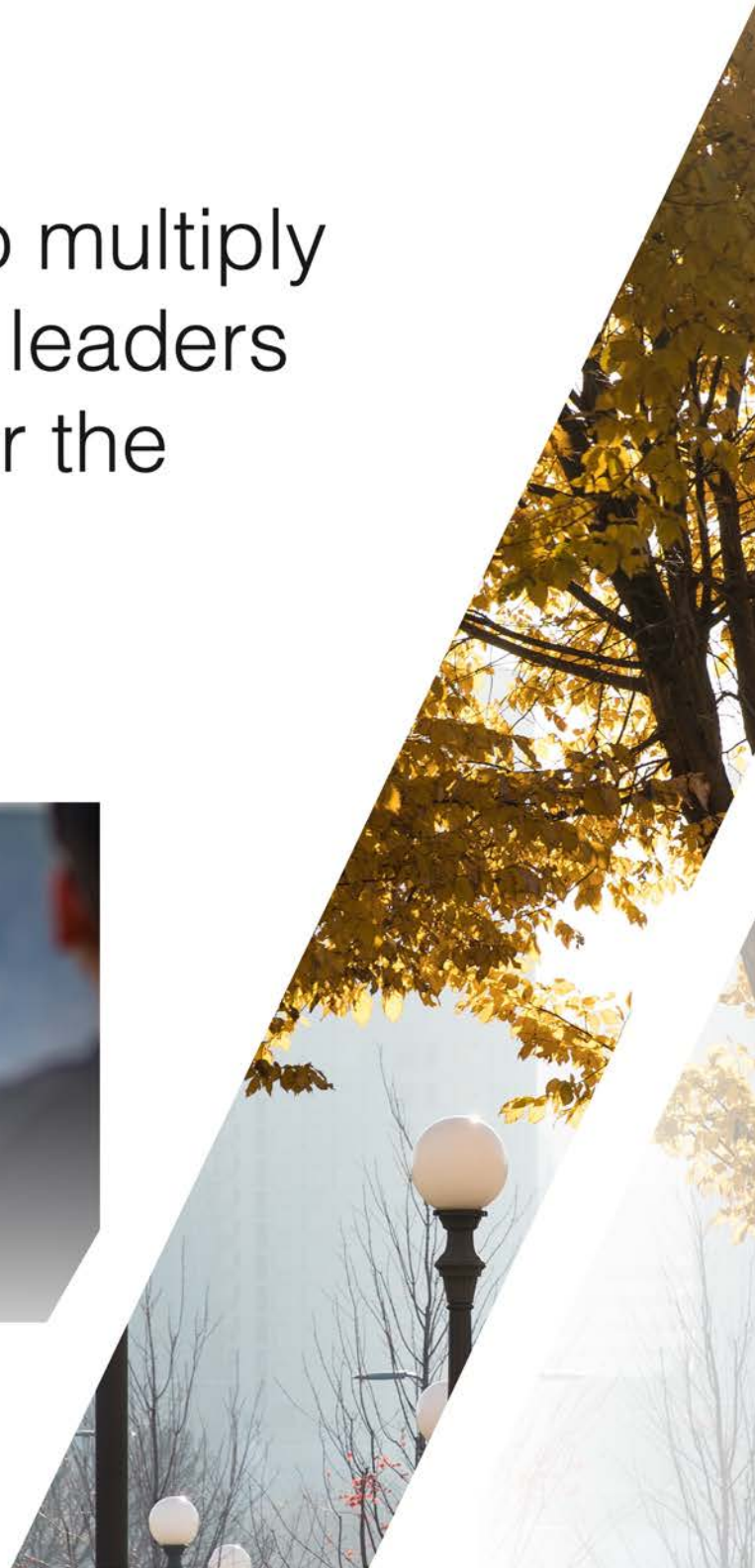
